It is our joy to share with you a new ministry at Canaan that is sponsored by the Circle of Friends. This ministry is one which we are so very excited to lead, and we pray it will grow to be a mighty mission for our whole church community.

First, take a moment and read the above scripture. The verse beats near to our hearts, doesn't it? For us "going to bed, going to sleep" is filled with good thoughts of softness, warmth, comfort, refuge, quiet voices and stories, prayers and love. It's a place of safety; We don't worry about having a bed, a mattress and bedding when we're ready to lie down for the night or a nap. These things are so very basic in our world and make our sleep "sweet".

BUT this is not the case for all, most certainly not for all children in Davidson County. Naively, we did not know or simply never paused to think, that this basic need is unmet for children just across the street, down the road, and throughout our community. The need is there though, and as a group of women whose mission is to better the lives of women and children, we are committed to meeting these needs through our "Sweet Dreams Bed Ministry."

This ministry will provide a hand-built bed, mattress and bedding to children referred by the school social workers in our county. Our first bed was built with much joy and laughter as we learned how to use air nailers, impact drivers and caulk guns. It also left us humbled, as we knelt and prayed God's blessings over the ministry and children who would receive these beds.

On March 18 from 3 -7 pm, we will be building a dozen more beds. They will be ready to be given out when the need is presented. How can you be a part? We are excited to host a "building party" with dinner provided. You can help build. You can come and pray over the beds. You can donate and support our fundraisers. There's a bake sale this week and a lunch this Spring. You can buy twin size bedding - mattress covers, sheets, comforters and pillows.

Each completed new bed costs \$300.00 - such a small amount for the impact on a child who is tucked into a bed created just for them by people serving Jesus together.
